

# Purebred Arabian Halter Prize Money Auction

This Auction is being conducted for the benefit of raising prize money for the 2007 National Open Purebred Halter Senior Stallions, Junior Stallions, Senior Mares and Junior Mare Championship at the 2007 U.S. Nationals.

The date and time of this auction will be From August 25th 2007 thru Sept 7th 2007, Midnight, Eastern Standard Time. The Auction will not end at midnight Sept 7th 2007 until 15 minutes have elapsed after midnight with no bids each individual consignment. Example: It is now 12:14 AM and somebody bids on item # 4. The auction is now open for another 15 minutes to that consignment and this will be continued until no bids come in during any of these 15 minute extensions. This is done so nobody is outbid at the last second. Each individual consignment shall be treated this way.

All of the proceeds from this auction shall be distributed equally between these four classes. How much each placement shall receive shall be determined at the end of the auction.

## Terms and Conditions

The items listed, IE: non stallion services, in this auction are being purchased in an as is status, which includes any purchase of a horse. If there are any disputes concerning these items, the purchaser and seller will have to resolve those differences amongst themselves. Ablackhorse.com or its affiliate company, including Holland Computers, Inc. are not responsible for any of the services, horses or stallion services purchased in this auction. All disputes shall be between the consignor and the purchaser. If you purchase a horse in this auction you purchase said horse as is and you will have 3 days from the date of the ending of this auction to make arrangements to pick up the horse from the location designated in the consignment information. After 3 days you will be charged a daily fee for the care of the horse, by the consignor.

The stallion services portion of this auction are for a breeding to that stallion, for the 2008 breeding season. The purchaser will have 10 days after the close of this auction to contact the stallion owner to make arrangements for the scheduling of this breeding for the 2008 breeding season. All pertinent contracts to complete this arrangement shall be completed between the purchaser and the consignor. There will be a consignment agreement on file with ablackhorse.com for reference. These stallion services include the stud fee, but do not include any other fees, IE: shipping fees, collection fees, those fees shall be listed with the consignment information and arrangements for these additional fees shall be agreed upon between the purchaser and consignor at the time of the 10 day contact agreement described above. The starting bid on stallion services shall be half of the published stallion service.

All bidders, must be a registered member of ablackhorse.com, Classified section simply go to the register link at the top of any page and fill out the information requested. Should the highest bidder at the end of this auction fail to complete the payment arrangements within 48 hrs, then the second highest bidder shall become the winning bidder. This shall also include the same understanding should any of the bidders fail to complete the payment arrangements, which means it is entirely possible that the third or fourth highest bidders, could end up being the winning bidder.

In the event that any of the stallions that you are the winning bidder on should become infertile or become deceased, at the stallion owners option, he or she may designate a stallion that he owns or has control of to substitute for the infertile or deceased stallion. This contract is good for the breeding season of 2008 & 2009. If mare is not checked in foal after two breeding seasons the owner of the stallion has the option to request another mare be used. The Contract is only good for two breeding seasons unless other arrangements are made with

the stallion owner. ABlackhorse.com bears NO responsibility between the owner of the stallion and the mare owner.

The proceeds from this auction, minus the costs to conduct this auction, shall go into a fund to pay to the Open Purebred Halter Senior Stallions, Junior Stallions, Senior Mares and Junior Mare Championship at the 2007 U.S. Nationals. If enough money is raised from this auction there may be additional monies available to pay to the reserve or top tens, but in no event shall there be a total commitment to pay to these additional placements.

There will be a minimum starting bid on each consignment and we urge you to remember that this is the beginning of creating a means by which we can promote and encourage participation in this industry. We have all complained about our future and the direction it is taking. This is a chance to make a difference and help the future be bright for this breed and this industry. This is not about a class or a horse or an owner. It is about the future we create for ourselves.
